

OSSTF TTBU Regulation Protection Council (RPC) - Procedures

- All decisions about whether or not to proceed with a complaint to the Regulation Protection Council will be made by the TTBU Executive.
- Per the Provincial OSSTF/ FEESO Internal Policies and Procedures, a formal Complaint to RPC “shall clearly indicate which applicable Regulation(s) or Article(s) of the Constitution is/are alleged to have been violated and the facts of the incident concisely stated, including the date of the alleged incident giving rise to the Complaint.”
- A Member who wishes to appeal a decision of the Executive to not carry forward a Member complaint to the RPC shall have an appeals process made available to them.

RPC APPEALS PROCESS

- An RPC Appeals sub-committee of 3 people shall be established from among the membership of the Constitution and Steering Committee. The RPC Appeals sub-committee shall be elected by the membership of the Constitution and Steering Committee.
- Member(s) wishing to appeal a decision of the Executive not to carry forward a complaint shall do so in writing to the Executive Liaison(s) to the Constitution and Steering Committee within 5 Days of being informed of the decision.
- The Executive Liaison(s) shall inform the TTBU Executive of the appeal
- The Executive Liaison(s) shall inform the members of the RPC Appeals committee of the request for an appeal.
- The RPC Appeals committee shall convene a hearing within 10 Days of the appeal being submitted.
- At the hearing the Member(s) appealing the decision and a member(s) of the Executive will each be given an opportunity to state their case to the RPC Appeals Committee.
- A written decision to either uphold or deny the appeal will be provided by the RPC Appeals Committee to the Member(s) and the Executive within 5 Days of the hearing.
